Structure : “such a/an + adj + [noun]” / “such a/an + adj + [noun] that”

	such	a/an	adjective	noun	that	
That's not	such	a	great	option.		
They are	such	---	nice	people.		
We had	such	an	interesting	conversation	that	we didn't notice the time.

Structure : “so [adjective] a/an [noun] that ” / “as [adjective] a/an [noun] as ”

	so	adjective	a/an	noun	that	
He is	so	interesting	a	man	that	everybody listens to him.
That's not	so	great	an	option.		
It was	so	beautiful	a	song.		
	as	adjective	a/an	noun	as	
It's	as	exciting	a	story	as	you'll ever read.
She isn't	as	good	a	singer	as	she thinks.
