1) as a form or means of something or to specify the kind of thing you are talking about.

- I'd like to say something **by way of** introduction
- The following day she brought him a bottle of wine **by way of** apology,

2) *little in the way of something / not much/enough/ nothing in the way of something.* **EN CUANTO A**

- He had **little in the way of** an offering.
- The town has **little in the way of** leisure facilities.
- Latvia is a country without **much in the way of** natural resources.
- Meetings held today produced **little in the way of** an agreement.
- The man with whom she maintains a relationship provides **nothing by way of** support.

3) *if you travel by way of a place, you go through it.*

- We went by way of London.
