- 1) a formal way of disagreeing or saying no.
- "Will you be going tonight, James?"

- Are they telling us the truth?- I think not!
- 2) used to disagree emphatically.
- This could be a coincidence, but I think not.
- Was their meeting a coincidence?I think not.

- 1) I think that what has just been said is untrue, but I am not completely sure.
- "Is he coming with us?" "I don't think so."
- 'Haven't we met before?' 'I don't think so.'
- 2) used to say very strongly that you do not agree with something, or that something is not possible.

- 3) sarcastic rejection

I don't think so is more common and shows a little uncertainty.
