



# **MOST OF ALL** phrase

You use **most of all** to indicate that something happens or is true to a greater extent than anything else.

Synonyms : especially, in particular, above all.

Examples:

- His music was the thing he loved **most of all**.
- **Most of all**, I just felt sad that it was over.
- She said she wanted **most of all** to be fair.
- The kids loved the circus, and **most of all** the clowns.
- Excellent experience today, everyone was welcoming, friendly and **most of all** informative.
