## **Every so often**

sometimes, but not frequently

 She still phones me every so often.

### (every) now and then /again

sometimes, but not regularly or often

- Now and then I receive letters from my former students.
- She comes to London every now and again

## (every) once in a while

sometimes, but not very often

- I still see Ken once in a while.
- Make sure you take a break every once in a while.

#### On occasion

sometimes but not often

 He has, on occasion, made a small mistake.

## On the odd occasion

Sometimes, but not often and not regularly

 Lack of sleep doesn't matter on the odd occasion.

## Occasionally

sometimes but not often:

 Occasionally I'll have a piece of chocolate, but it's very rare.
