**Having no personal involvement or receiving no personal advantage, and therefore free to act fairly:**

**Synonyms :** **impartial , neutral.**

- Not being involved in the argument, he was able to give a **disinterested** opinion.
- A lawyer should provide **disinterested** advice.
- A good referee should be **disinterested**.
- I was merely a **disinterested** spectator in the whole affair.

# uninterested

**Not interested**

- I complained to the hotel but they were completely uninterested and unhelpful.

**uninterested in:**

- She doesn't read newspapers and is **uninterested in** politics.
- I was and still am totally **uninterested in** competitive sport.
- Current energy suppliers are largely **uninterested in** small-scale energy generation.
