AGREE WITH : **ESTAR DE ACUERDO CON ALGO o ALGUIEN**

Means to accept a proposal or a person's point of view because both are the same - your point of view and their point of view.

Example:

- I **agreed with** John that the new prime minister should be wary of his words. (John's idea is the same as the speaker's idea.)
- I might not **agree with** you doing this on your own, but I understand your reasons.
- Don't **agree with** that rule, but that's the way it is until something gets changed.

AGREE ON/AGREE ABOUT- **ESTAR DE ACUERDO EN ALGO**

Agree on - plan, scheme, strategy that suggest two or more people have the same idea about what should be done.

Example:

- According to the meeting yesterday, everyone **agreed on** the application of the new rules and regulation effective next week.
- My father and I don't **agree about/on** very much.

("the application of the new rules and regulation" is the plan suggested by everyone.)

AGREE TO : **ACEPTAR.**

To Agree to something: Give consent to; accede to

Agree to a suggestion, to agree to an action proposed by someone else.

Example :

- Russia and Spain agree to Cooperate In Energy Sector
- We agreed to her suggestion.
- He reluctantly agreed to help her.

AGREE THAT : **ESTAR DE ACUERDO (EN QUE)**

A person can agree that something is the case.

Examples:

- We agreed (that) the proposal was a good one.
- I agree (that) he should be invited.
- They all agreed (that) it was too late.
