AS MUCH AS

Meaning : even though

- **As much as** I like you, I don't agree with you on this.
- **As much as** I hate to, I must work this weekend.

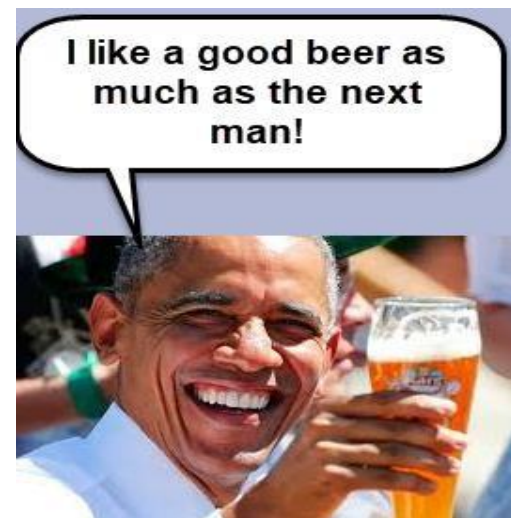
Meaning : an equal amount

- Most people can bench press **as much as** they can squat.
- Some women can drink **as much as** men.

as much as the next guy/person/ man ...

(as any other man or person)

- I like having fun **as much as the next person**, but tomorrow I have to get up early.
- I like money **as much as the next man**.



Meaning : equally

- I love you **as much as** I love your sister.
- I like football **as much as** I like basketball.

Meaning : almost

- She **as much as** admitted that she was cheating on her husband.
- He **as much as** said that he wanted to leave the company.

as much as you can do ... (to struggle to do something)

- I felt so ill this morning, it was **as much as** I could do to get out of bed.
- He was so drunk that it was **as much as he could do** to keep himself up.
