Meaning: equally

- I love you as much as I love your sister.
- I like football **as much as** I like basketball.

I like a good beer as much as the next man!

Meaning: almost

- She as much as admitted that she was cheating on her husband.
- He as much as said that he wanted to leave the company.

as much as you can do ... (to struggle to do something)

- I felt so ill this morning, it was as much as I could do to get out of bed.
- He was so drunk that it was as much as he could do to keep himself up.
