something is true, so that they do not worry.	To guarantee an event or condition; to make something certain to happen. To make sure that something happens or is definite.
or doubtful can be assured. THINGS CANNOT BE ASSURED.	Only things can be ensured. <b>PEOPLE CANNOT BE</b> <b>ENSURED.</b>
<ul> <li>Examples:</li> <li>Tom assured Mike that he'd come to the party early.</li> <li>She assured us (that) the car would be ready the next day.</li> <li>I assure you that I will do my very best not to disappoint you.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Examples:</li> <li>The role of the police is to ensure that the law is obeyed.</li> <li>The lifejacket had almost certainly ensured her survival.</li> <li>A good anti-virus will ensure that your PC remains virus free.</li> </ul>
