“next”

Talking from the present moment – (no article)

Today is Friday, 31st March 2017.
So, 2018 is next year. April is next month.
Next week, it's going to be sunny.
Next month, I am going to move to Germany.
Next year, I will be given a job promotion.

“the next”

Talking about the past compared to some other time in the past.

(uses article)

On Friday 31st March 2017, I wrote this grammar sheet.
The next day was Saturday 1st April
The next month was April.
The next year was 2018.
Last month, I trained with John at the gym. The next day I was sore.
More formally we would use :

'the following...!', rather than 'the next ...'!
