Let's not argue about money, **shall we?**

The answer to a suggestion with let's is normally either, yes, let's or no, let's not or sometimes, no, don't let's (...). Let's not is more common than don't let's.

– **Yes, let's.**

Let's go to the cinema, shall we?
– **No, let's not.**

Let's not go out tonight, shall we?
– **No, let's not.**

Let's invite Jane over this weekend.
– **No, don't let's do that.**
