- It was a difficult decision, but I had to do it, regardless.
- You get a lot of criticism, but you just have to carry on regardless.
- Whatever pressure groups and politics decide, the science will go on regardless.

Regardless of + noun = despite; not being affected by something:

Con independencia de / sin tener en cuenta / ohne Rücksicht auf (+acc) / egal without being affected or influenced by anything else that happens or exists

- The allowance is paid regardless of age or income.
- We will continue the race, regardless of the weather.
- I'll do that regardless of the consequences.
- There must be equality of rights for all citizens, regardless of nationality.

regardless of how/what/why/whether,etc:

 The building work will proceed regardless of whether there is an agreement.
