Regardless = despite what has been said or done

A pesar de ello / de todas formas / trotzdem

if you continue doing something regardless, you do it in spite of difficulties or other people telling you not to

- It was a difficult decision, but I had to do it, **regardless**.
- You get a lot of criticism, but you just have to carry on **regardless**.
- Whatever pressure groups and politics decide, the science will go on **regardless**.

Regardless of + noun = despite; not being affected by something:

Con independencia de / sin tener en cuenta / ohne Rücksicht auf (+acc) / egal

without being affected or influenced by anything else that happens or exists

- The allowance is paid **regardless of** age or income.
- We will continue the race, **regardless of** the weather.
- I'll do that **regardless of** the consequences.
- There must be equality of rights for all citizens, **regardless of** nationality.

regardless of how/what/why/whether, etc:

- The building work will proceed **regardless of** whether there is an agreement.
