## QUESTION TAGS - THERE



In sentences with THERE + TO BE (existential there), we repeat the pronoun THERE in the question tag.

BE TAG VERB : BE	There were too many people at the party, weren't there?  There is no bread left, is there?  There has been a lot of rain so far this month, hasn't there?
USED TO TAG VERB : DID	There used to be a sweet shop in this street , didn't there? There didn't use to be a tree in the garden, did there?
APPEAR TAG VERB : DO	There appears to be some mistake, doesn't there? There appear to be inconsistencies in her alibi, don't there?
SEEM TAG VERB: DO	There seems to be a problem with the radio, doesn't there? There seem to be a lot of people in there, don't there? There don't seem to be any people here, do there? There doesn't seem to be any hot water, does there? There didn't seem to be any differences, did there?
HAPPEN TAG VERB : DO	There happen to be people who agree with me, don't there? There happens to be a pretty barmaid there, doesn't there?
HAVE TO TAG VERB: DO	There doesn't have to be a difference, does there? There just has to be a better way to do it, doesn't there? There has to be something similar over here, doesn't there?
MUST TAG VERB: MUST	There must be something wrong with my watch, mustn't there?
TURN OUT TAG VERB : DO	There turns out to be a simple solution, doesn't there?
NEED TO TAG VERB : DO	There need to be more women in video games, don't there? There needs to be a properly informed public debate, doesn't there?
