Ways to Say an Action Is Not Worth Doing



There is no point in doing ...:

Doing it will not bring any benefit or result.

- There is no point in arguing with him. He won't listen.
- There's no point in waiting any longer.
 They may have already left.

It's no use doing ...:

Doing something will not help or change the situation.

- It's no use trying to explain it to her.
- It's no use crying over spilled milk the vase is broken, and we can't fix it.

There is no use (in) doing ...: Same as "it's no use"; slightly more formal or less common.

- There is no use in complaining now. The decision has already been made.
- There's no use trying to fix it yourself.

It's not worth doing ... : The effort, time, or cost is greater than the benefit.

- It's not worth worrying about small things.
- The movie was so bad it wasn't worth watching.

It's no good doing ...:

Doing it will not have a positive effect; often slightly negative in tone.

- It's no good talking to him when he's angry.
- It's no good pretending everything is fine.

It's pointless to do / doing ... :

Doing something is completely useless or ineffective.

- It's pointless to argue with them.
- Trying again would be pointless.

It's useless to do / doing ... : Stronger than "pointless"; nothing will work.

- It's useless asking for help now. There's nothing anyone can do.
- Fixing the phone is useless. It would be better to buy a new one.

There's nothing to be gained by doing ...:

No benefit or advantage will result.


- There's nothing to be gained by lying.
- There's nothing to be gained by rushing.

It won't do any good to do ...:

The action will not improve the situation.


- It won't do any good to complain.
- Yelling won't do any good.
