inasmuch as vs insofar as

inasmuch as - conjunction (formal)

Synonyms: seeing that, since

Inasmuch as + fact

used to explain the way in which what you are saying is true

- He was a very unusual musician inasmuch as he was totally deaf.
- Ann is guilty, **inasmuch as** she knew what the others were planning.
- They're rather similar, **inasmuch as** they are the same size and colour.

insofar as (also in so far as) - conjunction (formal)

Synonyms: as long as / only if

Insofar as + quantifiable fact (sth happens to a certain extent)

to the degree that

- She cites other scholars' work only insofar as it supports her own theories.
- The news is good **insofar as** it suggests that a solution may be possible.
- Looking back helps insofar as it helps you learn from your mistakes.
