## shout at someone

(anger)



## to use a loud voice when you are angry.

- I wish you'd stop shouting at the children.
- My teacher never shouts at us.
- Dad really shouted at me when I broke the window.

## shout insults/ abuse at someone

- He was shouting insults at the lorry driver.
- He was surrounded by a group of boys who shouted abuse at him.

## shout to someone

(attract someone's attention)



to use a loud voice when you want someone to hear you. You shout to somebody when that person is not close enough to you to hear you.

- He shouted to me to throw down the rope.
- He shouted to me from the other side of the street.
- I shouted to her from the upstairs window.
- I was on my way to the library when I saw Mark across the street, I tried shouting to him but he didn't hear me.
