WEARY

wary -adjective (C2)

synonyms : cautious / leery
careful when dealing with sb/sth because you think that there may be a danger or problem.

- Tourists should be wary, as pickpockets are known to operate in this area.

be wary of somebody

- She **is wary of** strangers.

be wary of (doing) something

- Always **be wary of** emails from unknown senders.
- I'm a bit **wary of** driving in this fog.

Keep a wary eye on sb/sth (phrase)

- to watch (someone or something) very carefully.
- The police will need to **keep a wary eye on** this area of town.

weary - adjective

synonyms: tired /tired of
very tired, especially after you have been working hard or doing something for a long time

- I think he's a little weary after his long journey.
- Here, sit down and rest your weary legs.
- They collapsed on to their beds, too weary to get changed.
- He gave a long, weary sigh.

weary of (doing) something:
bored with something because you have experienced too much of it

- She was **weary of** the constant arguments between them.
- He was **weary of** repeating things again and again.
